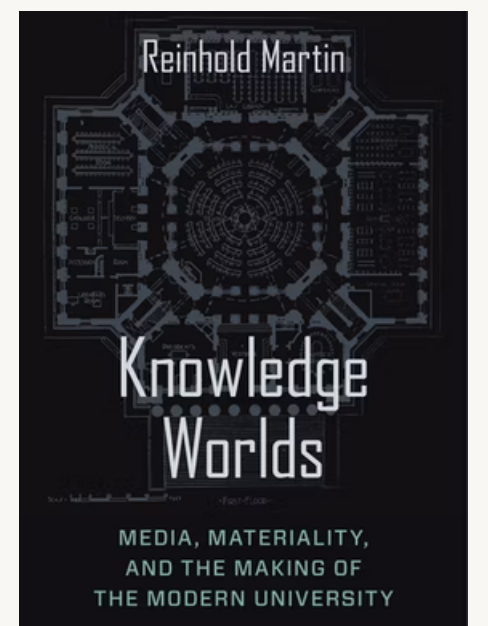

Reinhold Martin, a historian of architecture, technology, and media, is a Professor of Architecture at Columbia University. He currently focuses on the political economy of technology and philosophical aesthetics. His notable books include "Knowledge Worlds: Media, Materiality, and the Making of the Modern University" (2021) and "The Urban Apparatus: Mediapolitics and the City" (2016). Martin has also directed the Temple Hoyne Buell Center for the Study of American Architecture and chaired the Society of Fellows / Heyman Center for the Humanities at Columbia. He was a founding co-editor of the journal Grey Room.
